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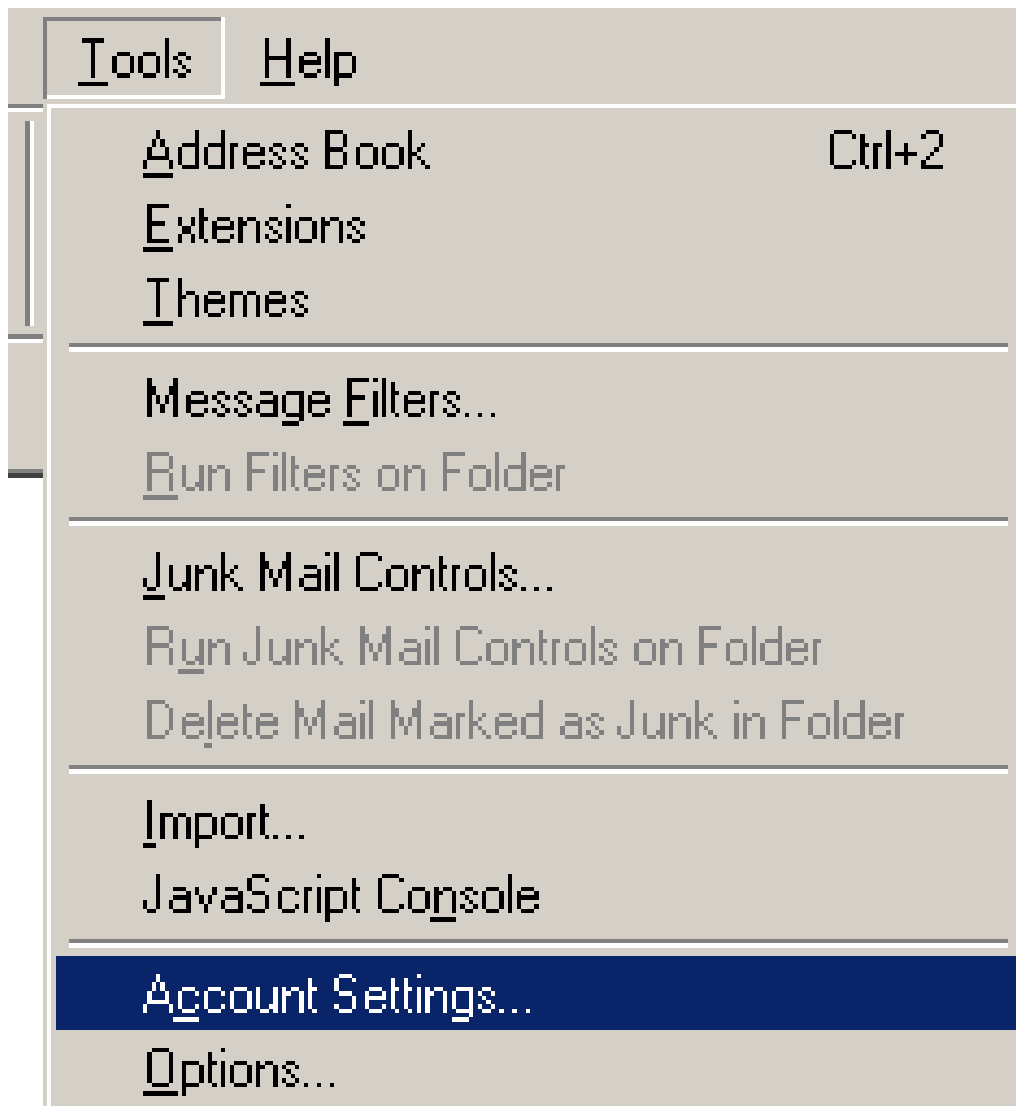

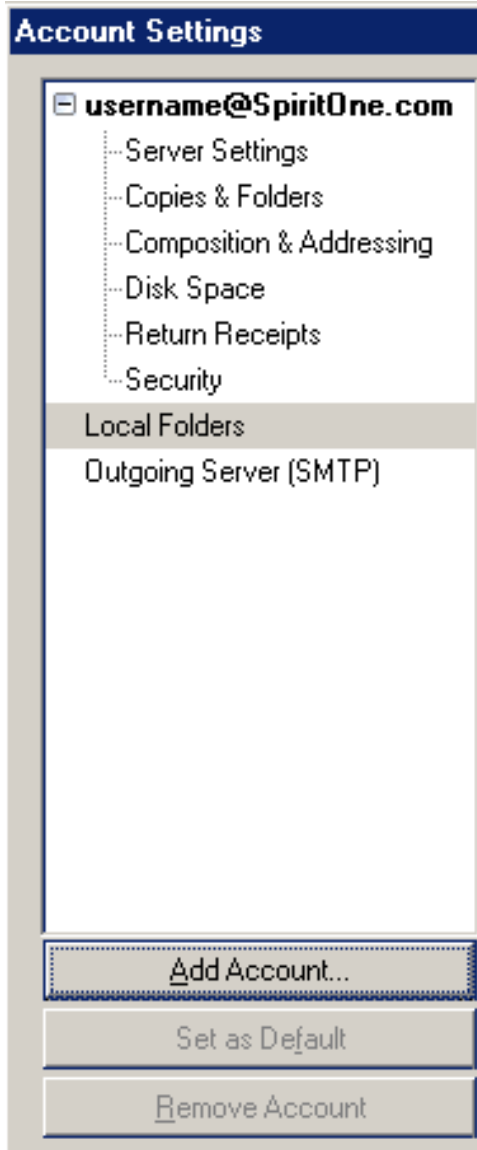
This document is intended to assist in configuring SMTP Authentication for Mozilla
Thunderbird



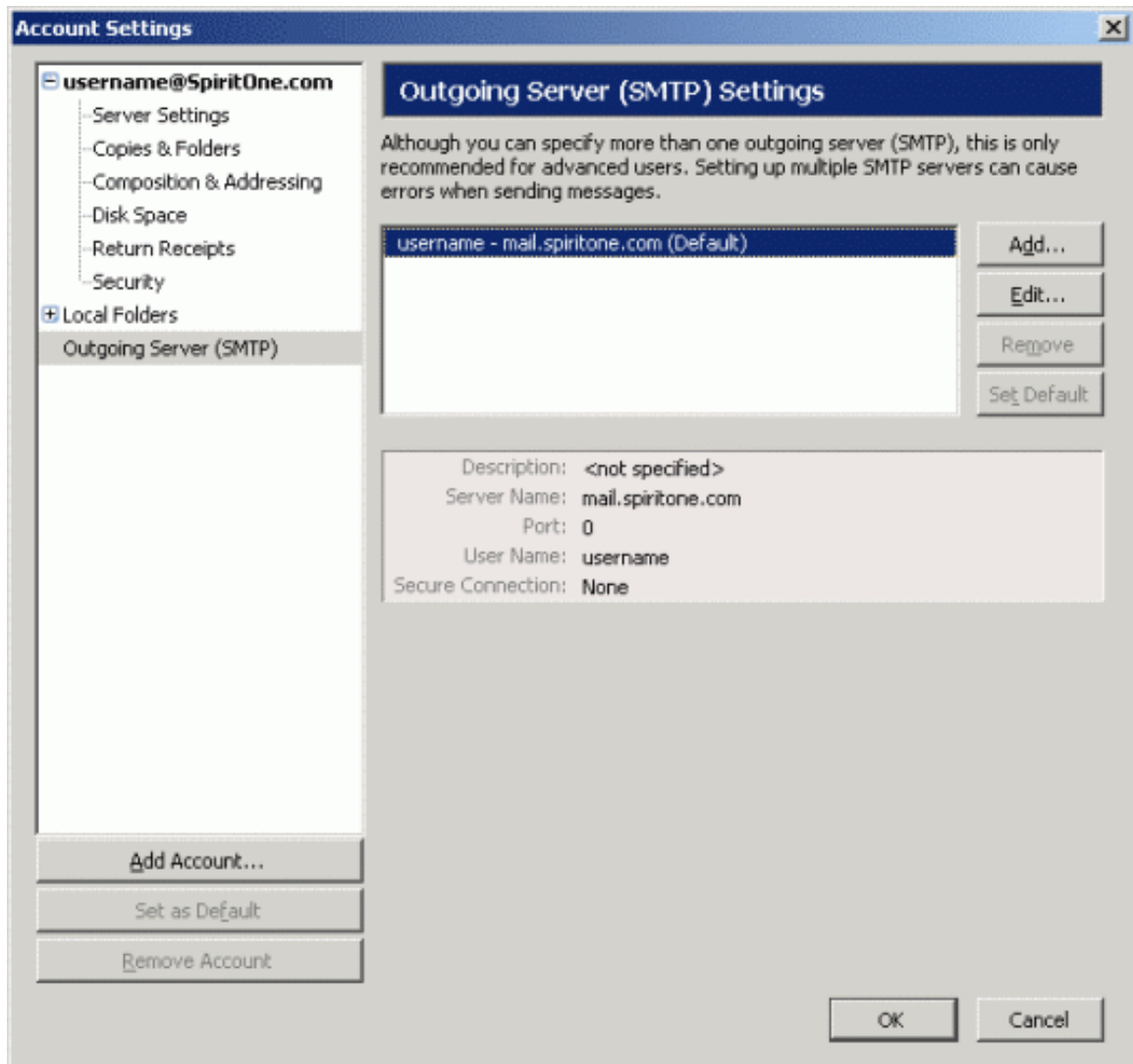
1. In Thunderbird, click on the **Tools** menu and select **Account Settings...**




2. Click on **Outgoing Server (SMTP)** on the left.



3. Select the outgoing mail server from the box and click on **Edit**.



4. Check the **Use Name and Password** box in the **Security and Authentication** section.
5. Enter your username in the **User Name** field.
